- BOD approved Aqua Weed Stick and Signage station Motion Scott/ seconded Del Scott, brought the major concern with the increasing number of Cormorant birds on our lakes.
 - Cormorants are federally protected, no natural predators, lifespan 11 years, fish diet
 - US Fish and Wildlife- contact to get permission to help control population
 - Potentially get organized with Mn Lakes & River to have a voice to fight the over population

Jeff Forester From Mn Lakes & Rivers Advocate

Statistic

- 37 years is the average amount of time a cabin stay in a family
- Mn has 500 Lake Association across the state
- Volunteer hours are the gears that drives Lake Association

LAKE STEWARD PROGRAM

Jeff explained what a Lake Steward is and how the program works. Adding lakeshore buffers help filter phosphorus before it enters lakes.

- Reducing phosphorus/ nitrogen in lakes
 (phosphorus shut off nitrogen and grows algae bloom and fish kills)
 - Run off pollution
 - Farm tiling
 - Not fertilizing lakeshore properties with phosphorus based fertilizer
 - Adding shoreline buffers, with native plants
 - No dump fire ashes in lake, ash contains phosphorus
 - Culvert not draining directly into lakes
 - Updated septic systems

A lake can handle recycling .02 lbs of phosphorus but, runoff contributes up to 2 lbs of phosphorus
